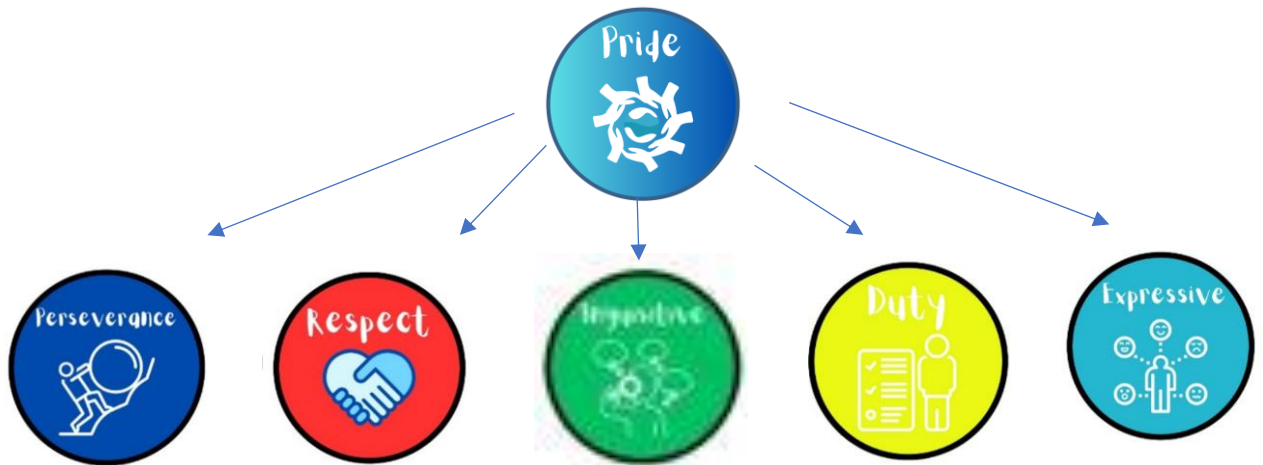


Newsletter

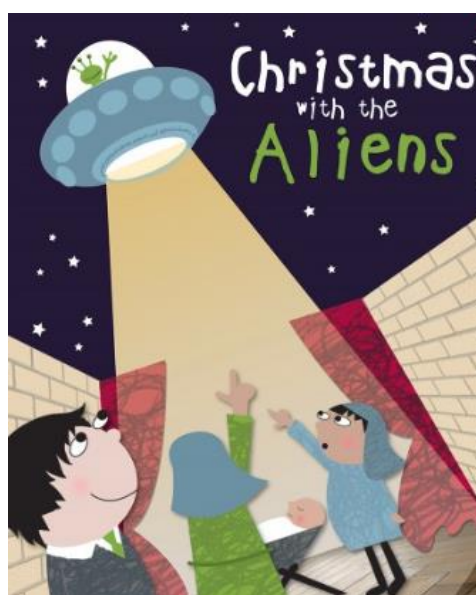


Nativity and Christmas Spectacular!
