

This week has been very important for our oldest children as they completed their End of Keystage 2 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) in Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling; Reading; Arithmetic; and Maths Reasoning. 6 Pankhurst are to be commended for the way they tackled them – focussed and ready, wishing each other luck before they began. We are proud of them all as they displayed our virtues of 'perseverance' and 'duty'. Well done to the staff and children of 6 Pankhurst.

Year 2 will be accessing tests during the month of May meaning that they have one more week to go. Good luck Year 2!

The month of June will begin with children in Year 4 completing the statutory Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) from Tuesday 3rd June to Friday 13 June. This is an online assessment whereby 25 random multiplication sentences up to and including 12x12 will appear on screen for 6 seconds before moving to the next one. Good luck!

Also, from Monday 9th June to Friday 13 June, our Year 1 children will be completing the statutory Phonics Screening Check. The children will read 40 real and pseudo (made up) words to test their phonics decoding ability. Good luck Year 1!


