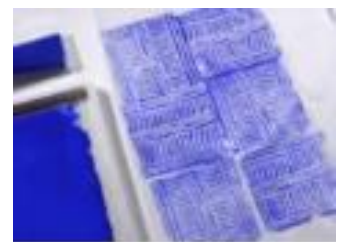

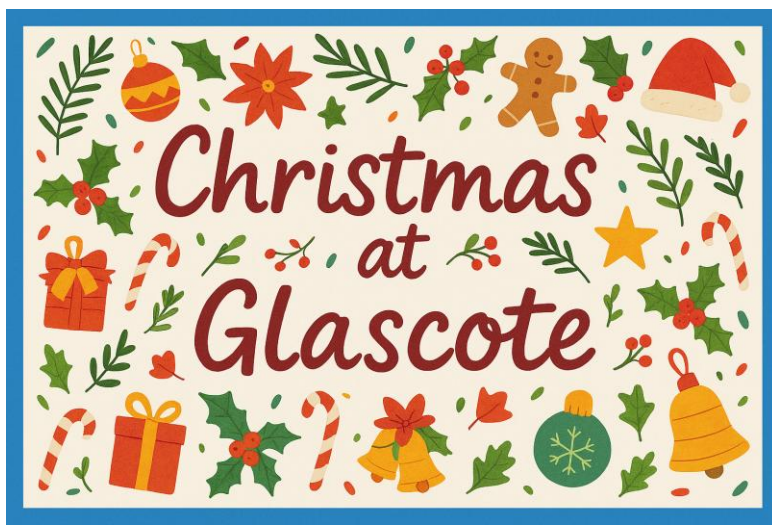


# 6 Derbyshire Fashion Show!
