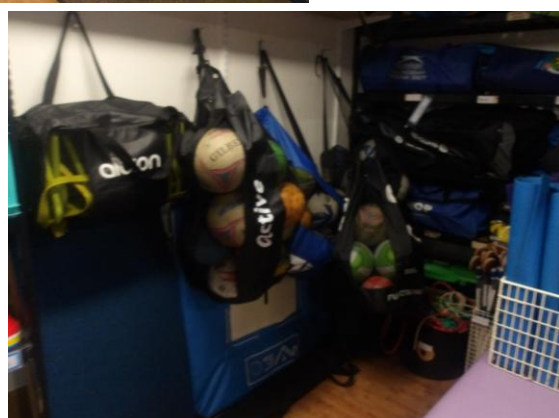
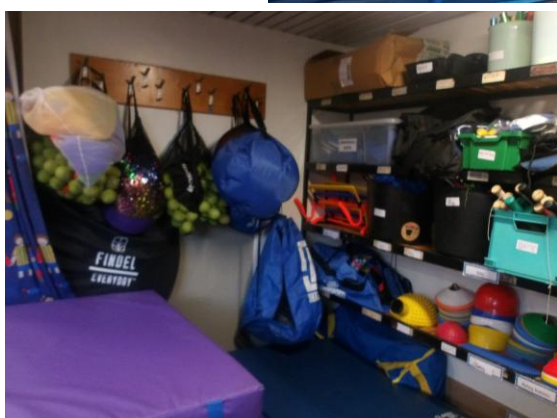
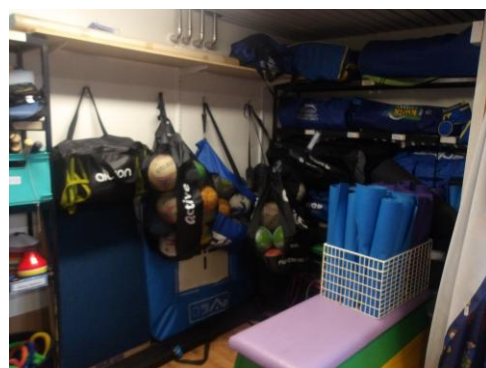
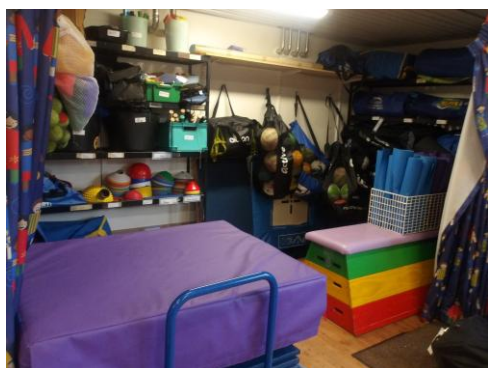
# Young Writers Competition
