Special Mention...

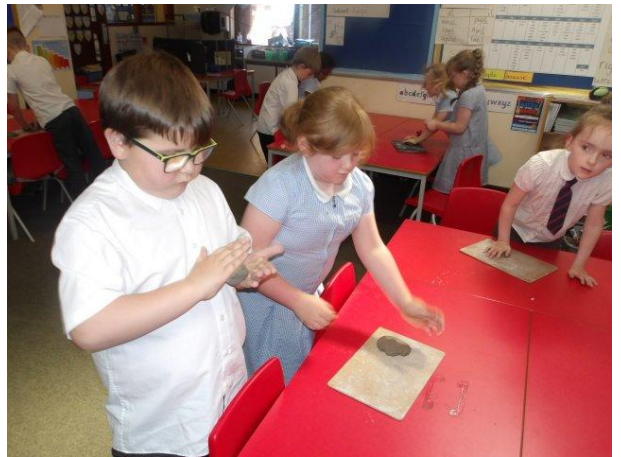

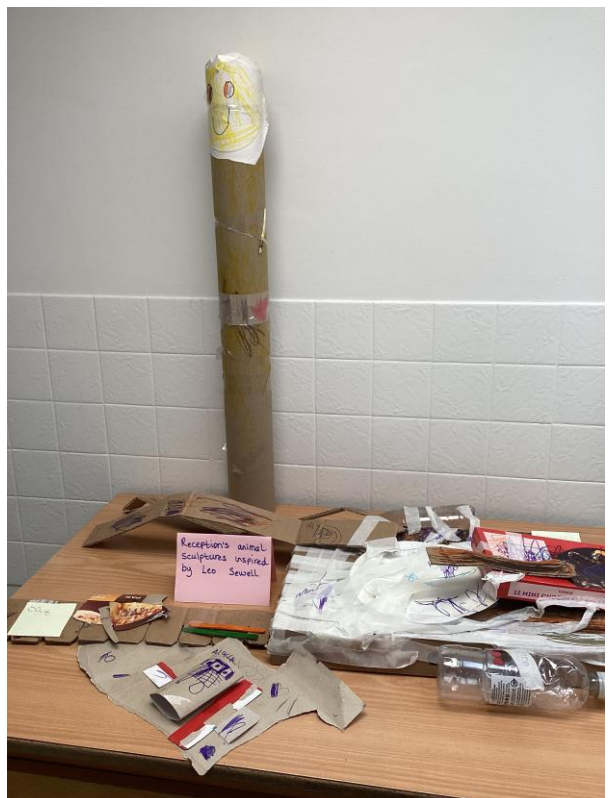


Expressive Artists at work!
