Below is a breakdown of our spending through the PE and Sport funding programme. We are passionate about sport and PE at Glascote Academy and we aim to increase participation in sport through our action plan along with developing attainment in this subject.

Furthermore, our programme provides professional development to our teaching staff to make sure we are all the best possible PE teachers we can be. The impact report below will provide a more comprehensive overview of our exciting plans for this academic year.

All of the improvements we are making will be sustainable in the future to make sure that PE and Sport provisions will be outstanding even after the funding ends.

Currently, the school is creating a 2020 Legacy Document which will be available in the New Year. This will detail how we are using the Sport Premium Funding to provide a legacy for children at Glascote and how the decisions we are making over this funding period will continue to benefit the future students of our school, after the funding has ceased.

In addition to the above areas, we are also focusing our attentions in the following areas to improve our provisions as part of the PE funding programme:

- Developing a central school PE and Sport board which showcases our achievements in PE and sporting activities completed by children outside of the school.
- Competitive links developed across MAT (with Violet Way Academy and Ankermoor) to promote competitions for our grassroots, infant children.
- Developing more effective subject monitoring whilst nurturing links with school governors.
- Continue to build on the success of recent competitive events, including producing the Y4 Boys' Cross-Country champion.
- Developing synergy between Violet Way, Ankermoor and Glascote through shared planning opportunities for parallel year groups.
- Exploring opportunities to follow on from an enrichment programme which has been in place since 2013.
- Development of school PE resource area with new signage and improvements to storage facilities.
- Use of music during dinner and break times to promote more physical activity (TA to support).
- Closer links forged with parents through a letter distributed by PE leader. Letter to ask for parents to send in pictures/newspaper clippings/etc of any events which our children are taking part in outside of school which are proudly displayed on PE displays throughout the school.
